

Crocheted Beginner Belt



PEPPERELL CRAFTS

Easy Beginner Belt - crocheted

Beginner:

Finished Measurements
Measures 1" (2.5 cm) wide x 36" long
(90 cm) without fringe

Materials:

One belt requires 25 yards (22.5 meters)
of Amy 2mm cord
Size K (6.5mm) Crochet or size
required for gauge
Beads for trim if desired

Gauge:

In sc, 2 sc and 2 rows = 1"

Stitches:

Slip Stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc)

Instructions:

Ch 2

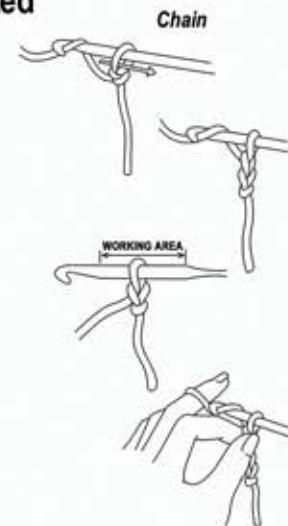
Row 1: sc in 1st ch from hook and 2nd; ch1 turn.

Rows 2 – 76: sc in each st. Ch 1, turn. Repeat until belt measures
36" long or desired length.

Finish by binding off ends or sear ends with a hot glue gun (no glue)
and fasten in place.

Fringe:

Cut cord into strands each approximately 32" (80cm) long.
Fold strand in half and insert into last stitches of belt with a Lark's
Head Knot. Add beads if desired.
