



The Coil Knot Layered Necklace

Materials:

- Five 1 yard strands of 2mm Amy Craft Cord
- Two ribbon crimp ends
- One closure
- Pliers
- Scissors



Directions:

1. The only knot you need to know is the Coil Knot (figures 1-3 below). Start from one end of the cord and work your way down making coil beads every 2"-4". They don't have to be even; and they don't have to be perfect!
2. Once all the cords are full of bubbles, finish off the necklace with ribbon crimps (figure 4-5 below). Crimp one end first, then hold the necklace to yourself to test the length and make sure the layers fall where you want them to. Trim the ends evenly then apply the second crimp.

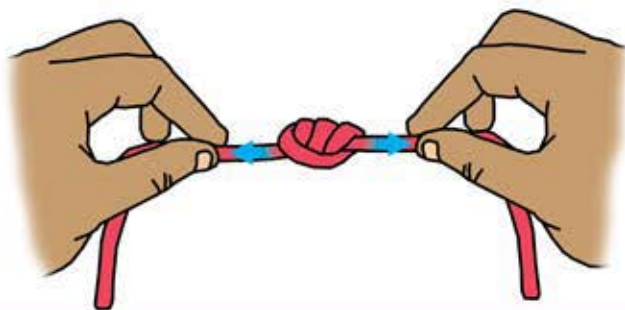

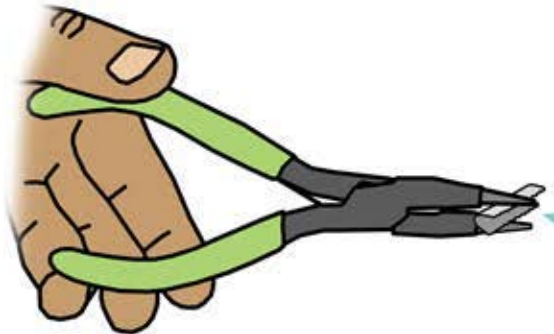

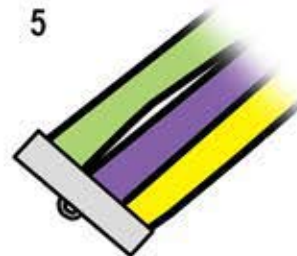
Use Ribbon Crimp
