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### Hanger Materials (Half quantities to make 1):

- (6) 8 ft / 2.4 m lengths of 1/4 in / 6mm Cotton Rope
- (2) 18 in / 45 cm lengths of cotton twine or hemp
- (6) 32x22mm Wooden Beads
- (2) 1.5 in / 38 mm Metal Rings
- Clear-drying craft glue & tape

### Pulley Materials:

- (1) Rope Pulley
- (1) Loop Ring Bracket (for hanging)
- (2) Medium Cord Connector Hooks
- About 4 ft / 1 m of 3/8 inch / 9mm Cotton Rope
- Masking tape, scissors, ruler and glue

### Directions:

- Center three strands onto a metal ring (**fig a**). Wrap the cords with a piece of cotton (or hemp) twine.
- String three 32 x 22mm beads onto every other strand and then tie an Overhand Knot to secure. Secure the beads about 4 inches/10 cm from the ring in a random pattern (**fig b & c**).
- Drop down about 24" from the top of the hanger and tie Overhand Knots using 2 adjacent strands. Repeat until you have 3 large knots (**fig d & e**).
- Drop down 2-3 inches/ 5-7 cm and tie a second row of Overhand Knots. This will form a circular lattice (**fig f**).

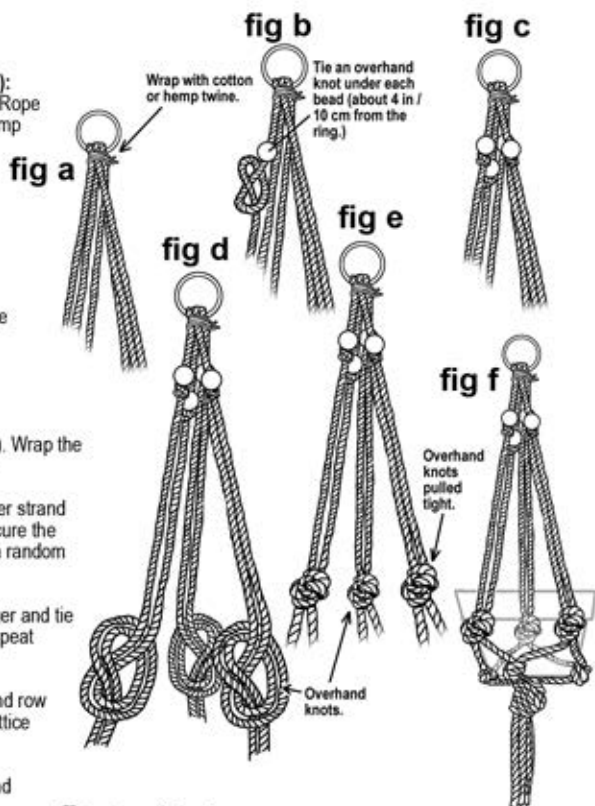
- Gather all the ends and tie one large Overhand Knot just below the last row of knots. (If the ends are too short, a piece of twine can be wrapped and tied instead.) Set a pot into hanger and adjust the knots so that they grip the planter (**fig f**).

- Apply glue to the tips of each cord and dry to prevent fray. Remove tape.

- Repeat steps 1-6 to make a second hanger.

- Follow the assembly directions for the Loop Ring to secure to the ceiling. Thread the 3/8 inch Cotton rope onto the pulley and attached the Rope Connector Hooks (**figs g-k**).

- TIP:** When hanging potted plants, keep the weight of both pots even to ensure the pulley is balanced.

Tape rope end for ease of insertion.

**fig h**

Open set screws. While inserting rope, turn rope in the opposite direction of the twist on the rope. Make sure rope goes all the way into hook.

**fig i**

Tighten screws with included hex key. Make sure set screw is well seated into the rope.

**fig j**

Pull on rope and hook to make sure set screw and rope are fastened correctly.
