

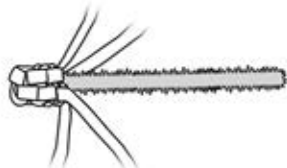
Heart Zipper Pull Instructions

1). Measure and cut 2 lengths of Rexlace plastic lacing, 1.5 yard each. You will also need one 6" length chenille stem.

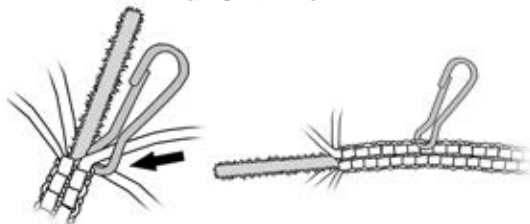
2). Finding the center of each strand, make a Starter Stitch (Square Stitch.) Try to keep this stitch loose. **IMPORTANT:** Turn the stitch over to the back side and keep this stitch loose. Form 2 Square Stitches.



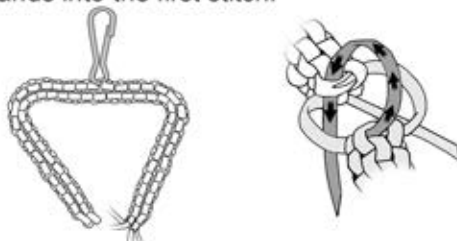
3). Making one more loose Square Stitch, stick a chenille stem in the middle of the stitch, then pull tight. Continue making Square Stitch around the chenille stem.



4). You will need to make a total of about 36 Square Stitch. Slide a Lanyard Snap onto one strand of Rexlace. Continue making 36 more Square Stitch. Trim the chenille stem as close to the project as possible.



5). Bend the working end of your Rexlace stem to form a complete loop. Align the ends of the project, and weave the working strands into the first stitch.



6). To secure, pull all ends tight while immersing the working end in HOT water for 20-30 seconds. Quickly transfer to COLD water for 20-30 seconds. Dry the project.

7). Dip the joint end in some clear craft glue. Allow to dry completely. Trim excess lacing. Bend the project into a heart shape.
