

Materials:

1/2 inch cotton rope (any desired length)
Large size Rope Ends (fit 1/2 inch rope)
Masking tape, scissors and ruler
Dying materials: Lined Bucket/ stainless steel sink,
cloth dye, rubber gloves, soap (and bleach),
water (HOT!) and drop-cloth/drying space

Instructions:

1 Tape off cut point from 1/2 inch cotton rope. Cut any length you need (fig a).

2 Leaving the tape on the ends, prepare your dye and soak the rope in hot water.

3 Dip the rope into the dye about 1/2 – 2/3 way up the rope. Allow to soak for 10 minutes. Move the rope around so that the dye can penetrate (fig b). fig b




4 Pull the rope out of the dye a couple inches and continue processing the end for another 5 minutes (fig c).

5 Remove the rope from the dye and lay out (or hang) to allow the dye to set. Follow the care instructions on the dye package. Allow the rope to dry completely (overnight is best).

6 Attach metal rope fittings to the rope ends. Follow instructions on the package (fig d-f). Re-taping the ends may be necessary.
