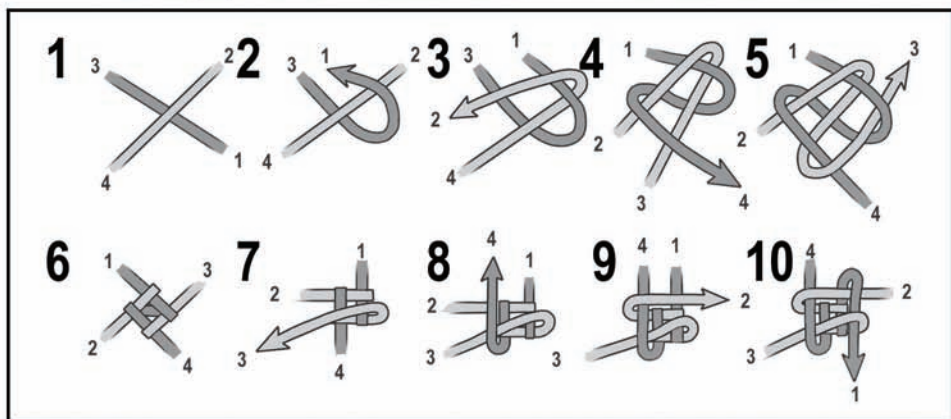
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Materials:

- (2) 1 yard strands of Rexlace
or 1.5 yards of 2mm Amy
or 1.5 yards of 325 Parachute Cord
- (1) Lanyard snap (optional)

Support Ribbon Instructions

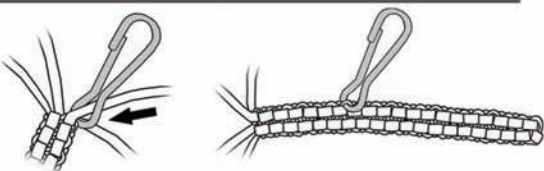


1). Cross the two 1 yard strands of cord at center and begin the Square Stitch as shown in figures 1 - 6 above.

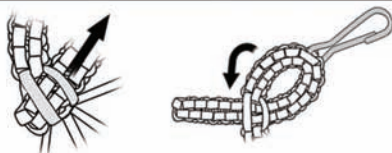
2). Turn over and make 26 Square Stitches (repeat figures 7 - 10 above).



3). Optional: T add lanyard snap onto one strand and form 12 more Square Stitches.



4). Make one more Square Stitch but **DO NOT TIGHTEN!** Bend the stem and slide the loose Square Stitch over the opposite tip. Tighten the Square Stitch once it has been positioned.



5). Make 12 more Square Stitches or more until the ends of the ribbon are even.

6). To secure, pull all ends tight. Trim the ends as close to the loops as possible. Dip the working end in clear craft glue and allow it to dry.
