# Decorative *Rope* Plant Hanger

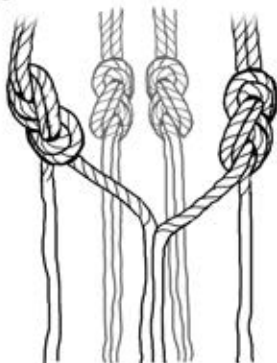

**Materials:**

- Four 7.5 foot (2.3 meter) lengths of 1/4 inch (6mm) jute rope
- One 1.5 inch metal ring (3.8 cm)
- Two 18 - 24 inch (45 - 60 cm) lengths of hemp
- Scissors, ruler and masking tape
- Clear-drying craft glue (optional)
- Macrame Assistant Tool (optional)
- The item to hang: potted plant/jar/bowl/etc.



- 1** Cut the jute into four 7.5 foot lengths and tape the ends to keep from fraying.
- 2** Center the four strands onto the metal ring. Gather all the strands together below the ring. Tightly wrap and tie one length of hemp around the bundle directly below the ring. (See **fig a**.)
- 3** Hang on a Macrame Assistant Tool for easy knotting (optional). Take two adjacent strands about 20 inches (50 cm) from the wrap and form one Figure-Eight Knot. (See **fig b**.) Repeat with other groups of two. Try to keep the knots at the same level.
- 4** Gather two strands from neighboring groups (**fig c**) and repeat the Figure-Eight Knot about 3 inches (7 cm) below the previous set of knots. Again, knot around the bottom of the planter.
- 5** Set the planter (or other item you plan to hang) into this center space to be sure it will fit. Gather all the strands below, remove the planter, wrap and tie the gathered cords with the remaining piece of hemp. (See **fig d**.)
- 6** Apply glue to the tips to prevent fray. Remove tape once glue is dried.
