

## Chair Pad – Knitted

### Skill Level:

Beginner

### Finished Measurements:

Measures 12" (30 cm) wide x 12" long (30cm)

### Bonnie 6mm Craft Cord:

Two skeins of cord each 50 yards (45 meters) in two colors.

(two 50-yard skeins is enough to do 2 pads)

Each pad will use approximately 25 yards of color A and 25 yards of color B.

Label one skein A and the other B. (Shown is color #005 Pearl and color #002 Ivory)

### Needles:

US # 11 (8mm) needles or size to obtain gauge

### Gauge:

In Garter Stitch Pattern, 8sts and 8 rows = 4" (10cm)

Garter Stitch Pattern

Knit every row.

### Stripe Pattern Stitch:

Cast on 24 sts working with the skein A color cord.

Knit one row with Color A.

Rows 2 and 3: Use color B and knit across

Rows 4 & 5: Use color A and knit across.

Repeat Rows 2 – 5 for Stripe Pattern.

Work in Stripe pattern until piece measures 12" square. Ending with

Row 4 of pattern. With a strand of A, bind off all sts.

### Stripe Pattern:

Carry color not in use up the side of the work. At the end of the second row of a color, both strands should be at the top of your knitting needles ready for you to switch to the other color.

### Note:

Bonnie Cord is made with polypropylene, a heat fusible fiber. You can join ends to change colors or finish without knots simply by fusing fiber ends. Use the tip of a heated hot glue gun (without the glue) to sear ends. Use caution and supervision with children.

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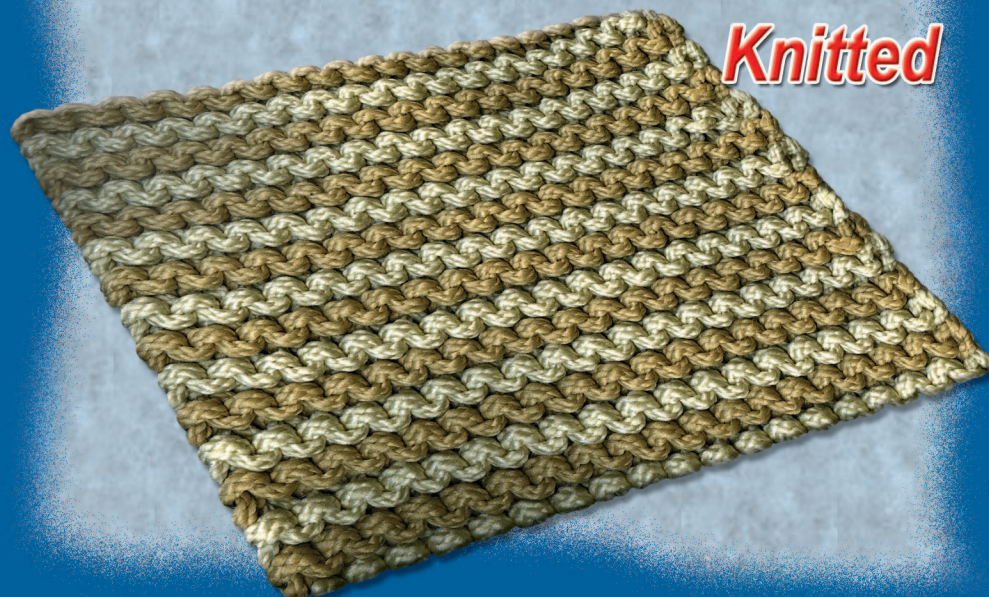
