

Sparkle Dream Catcher



Materials:

- One 6 inch metal ring
- One 4 yard length Plastic Lacing (ex. Jelly Cord, Rexlace or S'getti String)
- One 5 yard length of 1mm Stretch Magic® Sparkle
- One pony bead

Recommended Tools (not included):

- Tape
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Wrap the 6 inch ring with the 4 yards of plastic lacing, leaving a 6 inch tail.

TIP: Temporarily tape the knot to the ring to prevent it from slipping around as you wrap. See figures 1-2.

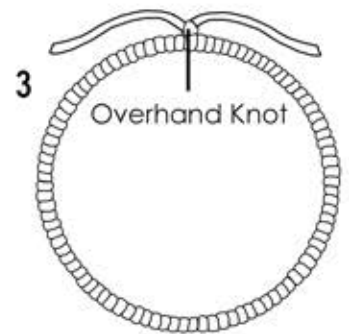
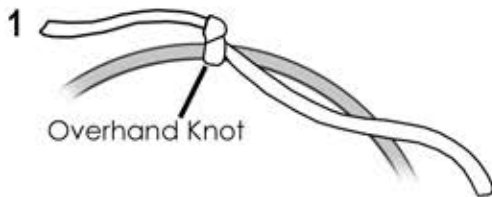
2. Upon the return to the top of the ring, remove tape (if necessary) and tie the tails together at the base of the ring with an Overhand Knot, and then again at the tail tips for hanging. See figure 3.

3. Tuck and tie the end of the Stretch Magic® Sparkle to the covered ring (figure 4).

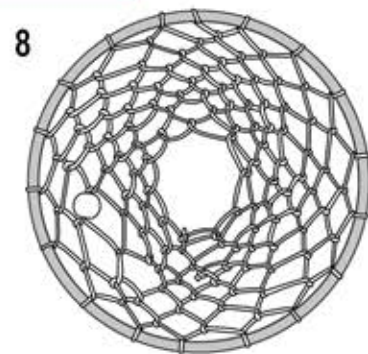
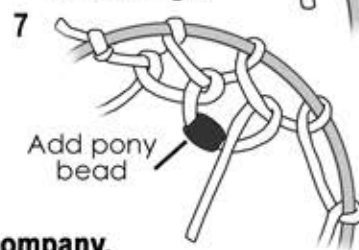
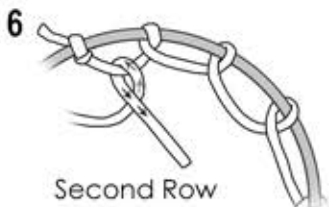
4. Fill the inside of the ring with the Stretch Magic® following the Half Hitch Web (figures 5-6). Along the third web round, slide the pony bead onto the Stretch Magic®, (figure 7) then continue the web until satisfied with its fullness. Tie off and trim any excess string (figure 8).
